

Scholarship Opportunities

With so many talented young artists from across the state attending Crane River Theater's *Backstage*, we are thrilled at the opportunity to recognize an outstanding student with a scholarship opportunity for the arts. Any workshop participant can register to audition as an actor or director/designer to qualify for a \$250 scholarship. All of the auditions and interviews will take place on Saturday, August 5, during the first workshop session. One winner will be determined by a panel of three Crane River Theater directors and announced at the closing of the Backstage Workshop. Rules on how to apply can be found below.

Choose one of the following options to be eligible for the Backstage Scholarship:

Option 1: Prepare a comedic or dramatic monologue to be performed before a panel. The selection should be no longer than three minutes.

Option 2: Prepare a musical theater selection to be performed with live accompaniment before a panel. A piano player will be provided, but the auditionee must provide sheet music for their selection. The song should be no longer than four minutes.

Option 3: Prepare a two-page design concept for John Cariani's *Almost, Maine* in one of the following areas of design: Scene Design, Light Design, Sound Design, Costume Design or Directing. The concept should outline your approach to the specific design area and the steps needed to make your vision come to life. Design concepts must be submitted upon check in on August 4th. An interview to discuss the concept will be conducted before a panel.
