Katherine is a professional performer, director, and educator at South Georgia State College. Her acting career spans 17 years in theatre, film and television. Notable credits include A Raisin in the Sun, For Colored Girls, In the Next Room, The 13th of Paris, and Speech and Debate. Katherine was recently honored by the Kennedy Center American College Theater Festival for the creation and direction of "Expressions... A Necessary Conversation". There is no better way to tackle the issues of diversity and inclusion than with storytelling. Crane River Theater will travel to your school to present this 90-minute production, followed by an optional talkback with the director and actor. Supplemental learning packets are available to teachers and students two weeks prior to the performance so they can reflect on topics before our arrival.
